Gerhard Wiesheu was born on February 12, 1962 and has worked for Metzler since 2001. He became a member of the Partners' Committee B. Metzler seel. Sohn & Co. Holding AG in May 2002 and has been in charge of institutional asset management since then. He is also a member of the Credit Committee for Metzler Bank and of the supervisory boards of the following group companies: Metzler Asset Management (Japan) Ltd. in Tokyo, Metzler Ireland Limited in Dublin, Metzler Realty Advisors in Seattle and Metzler/Payden, LLC in Los Angeles, a 50:50 joint venture with the US investment company Payden & Rygel.

Prior to joining Metzler, Gerhard Wiesheu was a managing director of Commerz International Capital Management GmbH (CICM) in Frankfurt/Main, Germany. From 1994 to 1999 he was managing director of CICM (Japan) Ltd. in Tokyo. During this time he was also a member of the Board of the Japanese Asset Management Association in Tokyo. Before his appointment to CICM he completed the investment banking trainee programme at Commerzbank AG and was employed in various positions at this bank from 1987.
